Connect2Compete®

Cox Connect2Compete is our affordable in-home Internet product for low-income families with a K-12 child participating in a government-assisted program. Connect2Compete supports eligible students and their families by providing low-cost home Internet with WiFi for only \$9.95* per month. Service includes access to the Cox Digital Academy and low-cost device purchase options.

Cox Internet

This solution delivers students Internet access to support applications, data sharing, posting, downloading and uploading. Options include **CARES**Starter Internet with speeds of 25 Mbps/3 Mbps and **CARES Essential Internet** with speeds of 50 Mbps/3 Mbps—both with free, easy-connect options. Customer premise equipment (CPE) is included. Cox Internet customers also have access to over three million WiFi hotspots and Cox Security Suite.

Multi-Dwelling Unit (MDU) WiFi

Ideal for apartments, student housing or multi-tenant properties, this option is loaded with rich features offering the Internet experience MDU residents are looking for. Provided by the property owner, speeds and pricing for this option vary based on the needs of the property.
